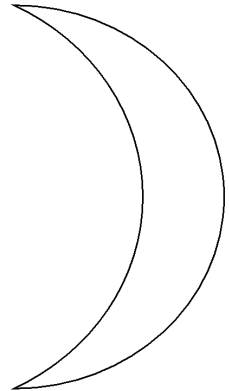
Waxing Gibbous



Half Moon

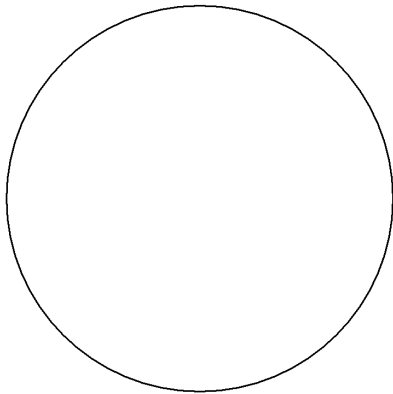


Waxing Crescent

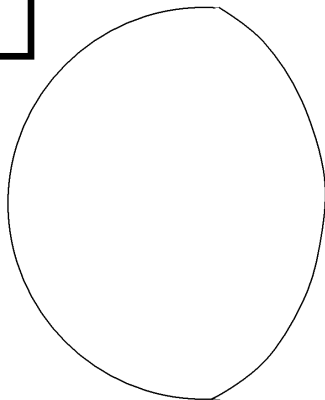

Hadeeth # 1

The Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said:

“The people will continue to be fine so long as they hasten to break their fast.”

Narrated from Sahl ibn Sa’d (may Allah be pleased with him)

Hadeeth # 2

The Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) used to say when breaking his fast:

ذَهَبَ الظَّمَأُ وَابْتَلَّتِ الْعُرُوقُ وَثَبَّتِ
الْأَجْرُ إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ

“Dhahaba al-dhama’ wa abtalat al-‘urooq wa thabata al-ajr in sha Allah (Thirst is gone, the veins are moistened and the reward is certain if Allah wills).”

Anas ibn Malik narrated:
